CVG Closure Detour - People were upset about the detour, Sebastian and Jasper wrote to the Port Authority about the negative effects of the detour.

New objectives

- Consider writing to future construction detours are of the same comfort levels for active transportation
- Come up with an official letter template that will apply to any future construction detours
- Work with HUB

Brentwood Pedestrian and Cyclist Overpass

- HUB Burnaby recommends Beta Ave because it involves the least stakeholders compared to the rest.
- Long term plan is to build all 5 overpass connections over the railway
- What are some parameters that determine success/failure? Multi-use paths, protected bikelanes? Come up with them until the next engagement phase

Bike parking

- Spoke with Vancouver LC about their approach and learned about criteria they use.
- How to tackle this large-scale project.
- Give out “awards” or “commodation” or “rating” to businesses that have good bike parking based on our own criteria.

- What is our grading system based on? HUB Vancouver has their own criteria, or we use the HUB Committee Resource

Action item:

Start a Discord thread for good examples/bad examples of bike racks/places that need bike racks.

Inquire with the City of Burnaby about bike rack requests

Municipal Elections

- HUB encourages us to lead elections advocacy? Looking for someone who is interested in leading that.
- Invite candidates to bike rides to explore some Burnaby infrastructure? Where and when?
- Do we do it during Go By Bike week?
- Looking for candidates.. But that can wait
